



# **2023 Huntingfield Cup**

## - Jubilee National Championships for Jubilee One Design Class Yachts 22<sup>nd</sup> April- 24<sup>th</sup> April **2023**

Organised by Ballaarat Yacht Club in conjunction with the Jubilee Class Yacht Association of Australia Inc.

## NOTICE OF RACE

#### 1. RULES

The regatta will be governed by the current *rules* as defined in 2021-2024 World Sailing (ISAF) *The Racing Rules of Sailing,* the rules and racing rules of the Jubilee Class, (except as any of these are altered by the sailing instructions) and by the sailing instructions.

#### 2. ALTERATION OF CLASS RULES

All nominated helmsmen or owners shall notify the Race Committee in writing of any change to helmsman prior to the start of any race. The number of crew shall not be varied during the series without the permission of the race committee. Failure to meet these requirements may lead to disqualification after protest.

#### 3. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- **3.1** The regatta is open to all boats of the Jubilee One Design Class that have a valid measurement certificate.
- **3.2** Each skipper and nominal crew member shall be a current financial member of the Jubilee Yacht Association.
- **3.3** Entries will be received from eligible boats on the Entry Form and payment of the required fee.

#### 4. REQUIRED FEES

The entry fee for the regatta is \$100.00 payable to the Jubilee Yacht Association by direct deposit to BSB 013355 Acct No. 8641638. Please identify your boat name in the transaction reference details.

#### 6. MEASUREMENT

Measurement is not required but each boat shall hold a valid measurement certificate. Boats may be inspected at any time during the regatta, and any boat found not to measure maybe subject to disqualification after hearing.

#### 7. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions will be forwarded to each entry on completion of registration and payment of entry fees. See Clause 3.





The regatta site will be at the Lake Learmonth Yacht Club, Foreshore Road Learmonth .

#### 9. RACING AREA

The racing area will be a designated area of Lake Learmonth.

#### **10. COURSES**

The courses shall be triangular, and/or windward and return, as described in the sailing instructions. Course Diagrams and Safety Checklist are included in this NOR for information.

#### **11. PENALTY SYSTEM**

Rule 44.1 is changed so that the Two-Turn Penalty is replaced by the One-Turn Penalty.

#### **12. SCORING**

- 12.1 The Regatta will be seven races over three days.
- 12.2 Five races are required to be completed to constitute a series.
- 12.3 When fewer than seven races have been sailed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.
- 12.4 When seven races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

#### **13. RADIO COMMUNICATIONS**

A boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio or electronic communications by means not simultaneously available to all competing boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones and GPS.

#### 14 PRIZES:

- 14.1 The Huntingfield Cup will be awarded to the winner of the Australian Championship being the boat that in the series gains the least number of points.
- 14.2 Individual trophies will be awarded for the following:
  - 1st, 2nd and 3rd places overall
  - The Les Pound Trophy shall be awarded to the first Victorian boat.
  - The Victorian JYA Trophy shall be awarded to the first New South Wales Boat
  - The Charles Peel Trophy shall be awarded to the winner of the final race.
  - The highest place boat helmed by a female shall be awarded the Porge and Ray Lady Skippers Trophy.
  - Other prizes may be awarded at the discretion of the Race Committee.
- **14.3** Trophies will be presented by the Jubilee Class Yacht Association of Australia at a presentation to be held on the afternoon of 24<sup>th</sup> April 2023 at the Lake Learmonth Yacht Club.

#### **15. INSURANCE**

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of \$10 million.
